

## The Hatfield Futures Project 2024 SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Using the year 2050 to spark our imaginations, the Hatfield Futures Project invites up to eight teams of high-school students to envision Oregon's future by generating policy proposals to address important social, environmental, and economic issues. Teams collaborate to dream up forward-thinking ideas and then present those proposals to community leaders, elected officials, and other members of the community at the Hatfield Futures Showcase.

Students will come to Hatfield Futures Camp at Portland State in early January 2024 to learn from community leaders, content experts, and one another as they build relationships and begin to shape their policy proposals. They will spend six weeks working together to polish their proposals, and they will make their presentations to a panel of judges, leaders, and community members at the Futures Showcase in mid-March 2024.

There are several opportunities for foundations, community organizations, companies, agencies, and individuals to support these inspiring students and join them in shaping the future!


